## Ages of Majority in Quebec and France

When we are reading the French marriage records, they always mention if the bride and the groom are minors [mineur(e)] or one who had reached the age of majority [majeur(e)]. What exactly were the ages of Mineurs or Majeurs at the time the marriage was celebrated? It varies.
